Withdrawal: S/1107/11, Tesco Stores Ltd – Installation of Storage Pod and Canopy.

Refusal for S/1207/11 to erect 4 dwellings following demolition of existing dwelling at 16 Teversham Road.

Permissions received for: S/1141/11, Metropolitan Housing Partnership, 312-322 Cambridge Road – Demolition of existing dwellings and the erection of 18 affordable (supported) dwellings with the use of plot 16 as office with associated landscaping, car and cycle parking and refuses stores;

S/1326/11, Tesco Stores Ltd to display 5 Fascia Signs; 4 Hanging Signs; 2 Directional Pole Signs and 3 External Pod Signs to Proposed Customer Collection Pod.

S/1384, 3 The Maples – Conversion and extension of garage.

New Applications: - S/1674/11, Golden Gables, Sanders Lane – Locating of a mobile home in the grounds of Golden Gables for one year to allow redevelopment of the applicants property elsewhere in Fulbourn.

S/1649/11, 10 Balsham Road – Conversion of lean-to store to utility shower room.

Tree works: – Home Close – Numerous trees to reduce laterals; crown reductions and felling. “More extensive than a previous application; tree canopy is heavy in this area and believe the proposals will not have a detrimental effect on area appearance. No objection”.

Cow Lane – Sycamore: Control canopy spread by reducing weight of long branches. “Tree very large and tall near house; proposals must add to safety of property. No objection”.

Bakers Arms – Numerous tree works: Fell dead trees, remove ivy and trim branches. “Site at present very overgrown, proposals can only improve, No objections”.

Church Lane – Remove Lawson’s Cypress. “Visited site, tree close to wall – no objection”.

Deemed Consent granted for 33 Cow Lane to Crown reduce an Apple Tree.
